Parent duty agreement and privacy statement – Updated Sept 07

Waverley Little Athletics Centre (WLAC) is managed and operated by volunteer parents. Our Athletics program requires the assistance of at least 60 parents each competition day to ensure the smooth and efficient running of the activities.

Duty this season will be rostered on an alphabetical “surname” basis. An even “split” of “A – K” for example will be required to fulfill duty **every second week.**

No experience is necessary, but we would advise that the “how to help” booklet is read in order to better prepare parents for duty. Parents are required weekly **by 8.30am** to assist with equipment set-up. Please report to the Duty Manager in front of the clubhouse to choose your duty task (first in best dressed).

An Officials day will be held on Saturday 22nd September 10am – 12 noon to help parents familiarize themselves with the requirements of all the different duties that need to be covered. We strongly encourage you to attend this, especially if you are a new parent to our centre.

By accepting this agreement, you agree to undertake your rostered Saturday morning duties. If you fail to fulfill this duty, or for reasons of work or family circumstances, you are unable to commit to this duty, a contribution of \$50 per family is levied per season. A list will be maintained this season to ensure that all families do their “fair share” of duty.

Please note: Whilst parent volunteers will supervise your children during their activity, they remain your responsibility and you are expected to remain at the venue in case of a medical emergency.

Codes of Behaviour: (a very brief outline/expectations)

All Children (regardless of ability) are here to participate, make friends, enjoy and improve their skills / general well-being. Sportsmanship, appropriate language (not swearing), respect of the rules and Officials decisions by both children and parent is of utmost priority. Positively encourage children’s efforts rather than results, and avoid “forcing” a child to do something they really don’t want to. Support your own and other children with an appropriate level of barracking (not overly loud so that you can be heard in another suburb). Treat others in the way that you wish to be treated.
